As you may already know, Chestnut Tree House is the children's hospice for Sussex and South East Hampshire, and they care for around 300 children and young people with life-shortening conditions – both at the hospice near Arundel and in families' own homes. It currently costs over £4 million every year to provide all their care services, yet they receive less than 6% of their funding from central government. This means they rely heavily on the support and generosity of the local community. It is because of events like this that they are able to continue to provide vital specialist care to local children and families.

All children taking part will be provided with their very own set of reindeer antlers and red nose to wear on the day. I have attached a Chestnut Tree House sponsorship envelope to gather as much sponsorship as possible to support local life-limited children.
