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## **Dear Parents and Carers**

Before half term, we invited an external assessor to examine our English and maths provision against the Quality Mark framework. This covers key aspects including analysis of the school's needs, strategic planning, target setting for improvement, support for pupils and provision of quality teaching and resources. The assessor spoke with governors, school leaders, teachers and the children about the systems and processes we have put in place.

The children were fantastic when speaking about their learning; they explained how the teachers ensure the class make progress, how individuals are supported or challenged in lessons, which resources they can draw upon to help them with their work and how feedback and self-assessment supports their progress. The children were so articulate and I was very proud to hear them talk about their learning in this way.
